Review of 2015-16 School Improvement Plan and Trustlands Budget:

Mr. Roper reviewed the SIP and expenditures already made or pending from our Trustlands Budget. He reported that schools in the State will receive 17% more this year, which for North Point equals \$5,925.00. Also the District reports that the school has a carryover of \$9,127.30 from last year. Mr. Roper reported that he email the faculty for suggestions of how these funds could be spend to meet our school's academic goals. Final decision will be made during our November 2nd meeting. Two suggestions were discussed. 1. \$4,500 for the school to purchase books to participate in the "Battle of the Books" program. 2. New Kindles or iPads could be bought for lower grades to replace the old ones that no longer work for Raz Kids reading Program.

Review of NP's Results on the 2015 Sage Testing and school grade:

Mr. Roper reported that the State gave the school a "B" grade. This is an improvement from a "C" grade in 2014 even though the percentage of proficiency went down, our Growth scores went up to give the school a "B" grade. He also reported that the school was above the State average in all areas, but below the District average. He doesn't perceive this school to be below average. The difference between above and below District average is

less than 1 student per class. Our October 19th Teacher Professional Development Day will focus on what the data is telling us and what changes we need to make to bring the school back up to above average in the District.

School Internet Safety:

New State law gives the responsibility to oversee school Internet Saftey to the School Community Council. Mrs. Condie, our computer specialist, will report to the SCC during our November 2^{nd} meeting about policies and procedures in place to insure student internet safety at our school.

Professional Development Day - October 19th

Mr. Roper review the agenda and goals for the faculty Professional Development Day on October 19th. We will be looking at what the data is telling us about individual and group academic achievement at North Point.
