Esther Gwynn read Article II, Sections 2 and 3 from the bylaws.

Cissy Rasmussen, the Region 9 Legislative VP, shared how PTA advocacy works and why it is important. PTA takes a stance on issues that affect students, their families and teachers. She disclosed that she is a member of another group that advocates one side of the Orem City School District Split issue, but in this setting is acting in her position as the Legislative VP. She encouraged everyone to voice their opinion in the appropriate setting when the meeting is adjourned.

Julie Walker, Council President, shared information about the survey sent out. 94.7 % of parents who participated in the survey want the PTA to take a "no" (against a split) position on the Orem City School District Split issue. The local PTA president, president-elect, and principal will participate in a vote for an official stance.

Cynthia Cardenas, Principal, welcomed everyone and thanked parents for their support.

Lori Willeitner, treasurer, shared a detailed treasurer's report. The budget was proposed for the 2022-2023 school year.

Ribbon Week will focus on Red Ribbon (anti-drug), White Ribbon (technology safety) and Blue Ribbon (anti-bullying).
