As the school gift this year, we will be providing school shirts for all of the staff and teachers. It will be given early in the school year vs. the end of the school year.

For the fall fundraiser, we need volunteers. We are having two cash boxes/payment areas instead of one to move people into the fundraiser quickly. Receipts from food purchases will be turned into Lori. Food options vary in price to accommodate a variety of budgets. We will have Texas Roadhouse, Chick-fil-A and nachos from Costco. There will be additional concessions. The Hope Squad will have a bracelet booth. Donation drop-offs for the winter gear swap will also be available.

The clothing swap date is October 7. We need more donations.

For reflections, all judges have been taken care of. We need more entries. Awards to be handed out at the assembly and/or individual classrooms.

Ribbon Week will feature a police officer at the assembly as well as themed dress up days and recess activities.

The Missoula Children's Theatre has been booked for another session in February 2023. Concessions will help cover the cost.
