## **Kindergarten Bus Information**

Many new kindergarten parents have questions about school bus procedures. Please read and keep the following information:

#### **General Information:**

- Buses for Cedar Ridge Elementary are only provided to students who live on the east side of Canyon Road.
- The district will only provide a bus if there are more than 10 students who would ride it at each specific time.

## **Parent Responsibilities:**

- You are responsible for looking up bus stop locations and times. Use this website: http:// bus.alpinedistrict.org/stopsandbounds/stopsandbounds.html. Type in your address, click on the circle that appears, and then click "Show Bus Stops". Then, click on the red bus symbol to find the times for your kindergarten session.
- You are responsible for completing an online registration process to let the school know which bus stop your child will use. This will be available at the kindergarten pre-assessment in August.
- You are responsible for waiting with your child at the bus stop until the bus comes.
- You are responsible for waiting at the bus stop for your child to be brought back home. It is
  district policy for bus drivers to bring children back to the school if there is no adult at the bus
  stop.
- You are responsible for teaching your child which stop to use to exit the bus. There are only two stops on our route. Your child needs to know whether he or she exits the bus at the first stop or the second stop.
- You are responsible for teaching your child which symbol to look for his or her bus. Each bus has a number, but the drivers also hang a signal in the window by the door for students to easily see which bus is which. Unfortunately, sometimes these symbols change throughout the year.
- You are responsible for teaching your child what to do if he or she misses the bus. Our secretaries in the front office are here to help.

### **School Responsibilities:**

- We will provide each student who rides the bus with a tag that will attach to his or her backpack. The tag will indicate which stop your child will be using and which bus he or she should ride. This should help our bus drivers in case your child cannot remember which stop to use.
- A teacher or aide will help AM kindergarten students get on the bus.
- At the 2:15pm and 3:30pm end times, two 6th grade students will come and escort PM kindergarten students to their bus.
