

#### Introduction

Cedar Ridge Elementary School opened its doors in August of 1997. Since that time, we have consistently provided an excellent learning environment for our students.

In addition to teaching the State Core, our emphasis has been on promoting excellent citizenship through encouraging character development and patriotism. Our character development traits for the year are:

#### **Demographics**

We currently have 1019 students enrolled in regular classes at Cedar

Ridge Elementary School. Our studentto-teacher ratio for these students is 29 to one. We also have a Life Skills class with one teacher and eleven students.

The SCC also allocates Trustland funds to improve academic programs. At the beginning of this school



intervention for reading, as well as support for math. Since then, resources have been expanded to provide an hourly aide to each grade level every day. These aides help children with all kinds of learning needs and support regular class instruction. #### **Academic Achievement**

The students at Cedar Ridge Elementary consistently score high on end-of-year state assessments. For the end of year assessments last year, our school-wide proficiency was 91% in Language Arts and Math, and 88% in Science. We are looking at our data and identifying students who need interventions to ensure that our scores will be even higher in 2014.
