
SAGE 2014 - Cedar Ridge Elementary


We are pleased to announce our proficiency scores from the Spring 2014 statewide SAGE Assessments.


Since this was a new test on new standards, the main purpose is to establish a benchmark on which to measure future growth. Because comparisons to previous years' scores are not valid, the best way to interpret our scores is to compare how our students did to other schools in our area and across the state.

The students at Cedar Ridge Elementary performed very well compared to other schools. We scored at least 20 points above state average in Language Arts, Math, and Science. Our school was listed as the #26th elementary school in Science in the state by the Deseret News. We know that test scores are only a part of a child's school experience, but we are excited to share that all the hard work of our children, teachers, and parents is reflected in our scores.









Cedar Ridge Elementary stands out as a school with scores that are consistently high compared to local charter schools.







These graphs show how our individual grade levels did compared to other schools. While our scores are higher than most, we recognize that we still had too many students who did not reach proficiency on the SAGE tests last year.
